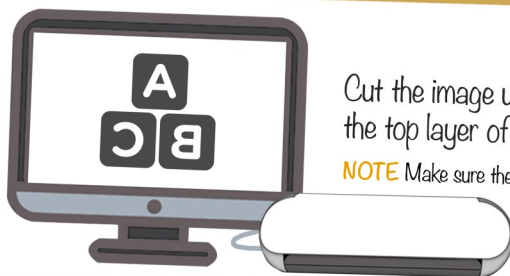


# PU SOFTSHELL

The Softshell series is a collection of 7 colours, which are thin and opaque PU films with a metalized layer. Softshell has a matt finish.

Cut the image using a plotter or contour cutter. Only cut the top layer of material and not the clear transfer liner.

**NOTE** Make sure the image is reversed in your cutting software.

Weed away any excess material until the finished image is left on the clear release liner.

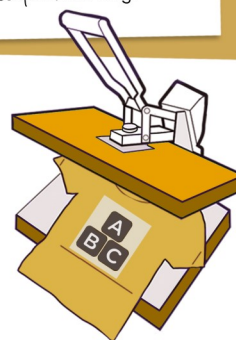
This is called 'weeding'

**TIP** Weeding tweezers make this process quick and easy.

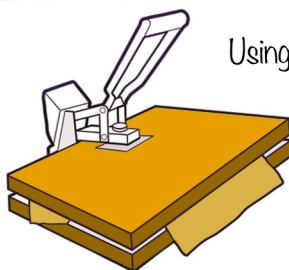

**Do not pre-press the garment.**

Ensure a flat surface for transfer and place the image or design face down onto the garment. Once positioned cover the design using a silicone sheet for protection.

Using medium pressure (3-4 bar) press for 10 seconds at 110°C

**IF USING A DOMESTIC IRON**



Ensure the garment is on a flat surface and is crease free. With a **low** heat, Iron firmly & slowly over the protective sheet in both vertical & horizontal lines for 10 seconds.

**Warm Peel**

Remove the silicone sheet and peel away the clear transfer liner whilst the material is still warm.

**NOTE** Leave for 24 hours before washing & stretching.
